



Arabian Oryx (Oryx leucoryx) are endemic to the Arabian Peninsula. They are the largest of the antelopes that once grazed the plains and deserts of the region and are uniquely adapted to the extremely arid environment. The beautiful body and the shape of the eyes of the Arabian Oryx inspired many Arabian poets who wrote of their beauty. Sadly, the Arabian Oryx were relentlessly persecuted until the last wild individuals were hunted in 1972. Thankfully, regional and international efforts through captive breeding and reintroduction initiatives have successfully restored the species in the Arabian Peninsula.

THE GENERAL SECRETARIAT FOR THE CONSERVATION OF THE ARABIAN ORYX (GSCAO): CHAMPIONING THE CAUSE OF ARABIAN ORYX CONSERVATION

GSCAO was established in 2001 with the key role of supporting all efforts to protect and conserve the Arabian Oryx, to agree regional criteria and standards, and to coordinate efforts between range states. The GSCAO is hosted by the Environment Agency - Abu Dhabi (EAD). Examples of key milestones of the GSCAO include:

- Development of the Arabian Oryx Regional Conservation Strategy and Action Plan in 2007
- Launching the GSCAO's website www.arabianoryx.org in 2013
- Surveying the Arabian Oryx disease in the range states (2011, 2013, 2015, 2018)
- Developing the first ever Arabian Oryx Housing and Husbandry guidelines in 2018, with partner institutions and members of the GSCAO's Technical Advisory Group.

GSCAO'S AREAS OF RESEARCH AND COLLABORATION

GSCAO raises the profile of Arabian Oryx Conservation in the region and supports range state countries through information sharing and capacity building. This is implemented through technical workshops that are organised based on the identified needs and priorities of local institutions of Arabian Oryx in the range states. Key conservation topics are determined through the GSCAO's five-year strategic work plans that are developed and agreed together with range states and partner institutions across the regions. Key work areas include:

- Reintroduction
- · Conservation breeding
- · Housing and Husbandry guidelines
- Veterinary care
- · Genetic management
- · Conservation planning
- · Wildlife Record keeping
- · Wildlife monitoring & ranger training
- · Wildlife law enforcement
- Conservation education and awareness
- Capacity building
